

Preparing Your Items

Please contact us if you have any questions before you prepare your items!!!

Supplies Needed: The following items are helpful to have on-hand during preparation: scissors, clear packing tape (not Scotch tape), med-large safety pins, ziplock bags, narrow ribbon and or string, a tagging gun if you have a lot of clothing.

Larger or more expensive items sell better if a print-out that shows the original retail price is attached. This shows the shopper what a wonderful deal your item is even though it may appear to be more expensive at first glance.

Clothing

- Place all items on children's hangers with the opening of the hook facing left (like a question mark).
- Clothing hung neatly will be more appealing to shoppers and will have a better chance at selling.
- If an outfit contains a top and bottom, pin the pants/skirt/bloomers/etc. to the back of the top using two safety pins, going THRU the hanger (this allows buyers to examine the item without it slipping off the hanger or getting misplaced). Be sure the item in the back is pinned so that the front of the item is shown when from the back. If an item contains more than one top (i.e. shirt and jacket with bottom, or shirt and sweater with bottom). You may "layer" the items as long as you leave as much of the inside layer exposed as possible. Still safety-pin the bottoms through the tops and hanger to prevent slipping or misplacement. If item is an outfit - print only one tag indicating the # of pieces included w/ description.



- Safety pin all other items of an outfit (i.e. bib, hat, booties, etc.) to the top left of the hanger so that your tag does not get covered.
- After your items are completely prepared and tagged, sort them by gender and size. We will NOT separate items by season.
- Attach shoes together using a string or zip tie so they do not get separated. Attach tags with safety pin, etc... DO NOT USE TAPE. REMINDER: Bring only your BEST QUALITY shoes only.
- Pants must be pinned to the top of the hanger-not folded over or pinned to the bottom of the hanger. You will be responsible for making any changes at check-in. \Make sure all buttons are buttoned, snaps snapped, etc. Make your items look like they belong on a store rack!

Toys, Books, Baby Items, Equipment

TIP: If available, attach any instruction manuals or owner's guides to your toys and equipment. Again, any extra information can really grab a shopper's attention!

- All items must be CLEAN! Taking the time to wipe down your items will make them MUCH more appealing to shoppers. If an item is not cleaned prior to drop off, you may be asked to remove it from your inventory.
- Secure all small parts belonging with toys in a ziplock bag taped shut. Secure the bag to the toy using clear packing tape or ribbon. Loose items will easily be misplaced.
- Books may be sold individually, but often sell better in a grouping. If you decide to group your books together, use rubber bands. Do NOT TAPE TAG TO BOOKS.
- Games, toys, etc. must have all pieces and parts. DO NOT TAPE box shut.
- All battery operated toys, electronics, and games must contain working batteries. They will be tested at check-in. Battery operated toys containing non-working batteries are not accepted.
